On May 8, 2009 the City of Oakland Planning & Zoning Division ("Zoning") sent the East Bay Zoological Society ("Zoo") a Letter of Incompleteness regarding the Subject Application submitted April 20, 2009 ("Application"). Zoning staff was contacted yesterday by Zoo staff and the letter was discussed. In the interest of keeping the project moving forward, this letter memorializes that discussion.

Please review the following:

#### Fencing

The Zoo acknowledges that there is a procedure for the Zoo to follow in order to obtain final approval of the precise location of the perimeter fence ("procedure"), that the Zoo to date has not commenced the procedure, and that the Zoo will commence the procedure.

The Zoo has not indicated the disposition of this request.

### Tentative schedule

The Zoo raised the point that the submittal of the administrative draft of the environmental review is not on schedule and therefore that the tentative meetings schedule may not be met.

Staff acknowledges the Zoo has stated the tentative schedule is just that, and may require adjustment due to outstanding documents not submitted by the Zoo as of yet. Additionally, unforeseen City closures and/or meeting cancellations that may be adopted by the City Council may impact staff review time. Adjustments to the schedule necessitated by the Zoo or City Council may not allow for the City to keep this item scheduled for Planning Commission in August and City Council in September. Zoning is here to ensure you will get the best project in the timeliest manner. To that end, please contact Zoning staff to discuss the nexus of these various factors including Building Permits at your convenience.
