

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 23rd day of January, 1968, by and between East Bay Botanical and Zoological Society, hereinafter called "Society," and the City of Oakland Park Commission, hereinafter called "Commission,"

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to secure both parties as to how a donation made by the Society to the Commission will be expended, and

WHEREAS, the Society does offer to pay to the Commission for a period up to 24 months the amount of \$1,000 per month, subject to review and evaluation every six months by the Society and the Commission jointly meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the Commission accepts this gift of \$1,000 per month for the period of 24 months for the purpose of developing complete plans and specifications which will conclude the planning of the now proposed veldt area, which is described on Sheet 2 of the Master Plan, Oakland Zoo, Site Analysis, and

FURTHER, it is the intent of the Society and the Commission that this gift of \$1,000 per month may be cancelled on 30-day notice given by either party to the other party, and

FURTHER, the Society and the Commission agree that at the joint meeting every six months an evaluation of the project will be made, and that objections made by either party will be set forth in writing and on agreement by both parties will be directed to the Superintendent of Parks to make the necessary adjustments in the proposed program.

FURTHER, the Commission agrees to the following:

1. The services of the person employed will be under the exclusive direction of the Commission, but that the department will be required monthly to make a progress report before the Park Commission and before the Society Board of Directors.

2. That this designer will be instructed by the Superintendent of Parks in the creation of a plan which will include some pedestrain experience and some mechanical ride experience.

3. That from time to time between each six-month review the Chairman of the Park Commission will call for joint meetings between the Commission and the Society Board of Directors.

4. That the Commission will make every effort to obtain from the Oakland City Council funds to match those generously contributed by the Society.
