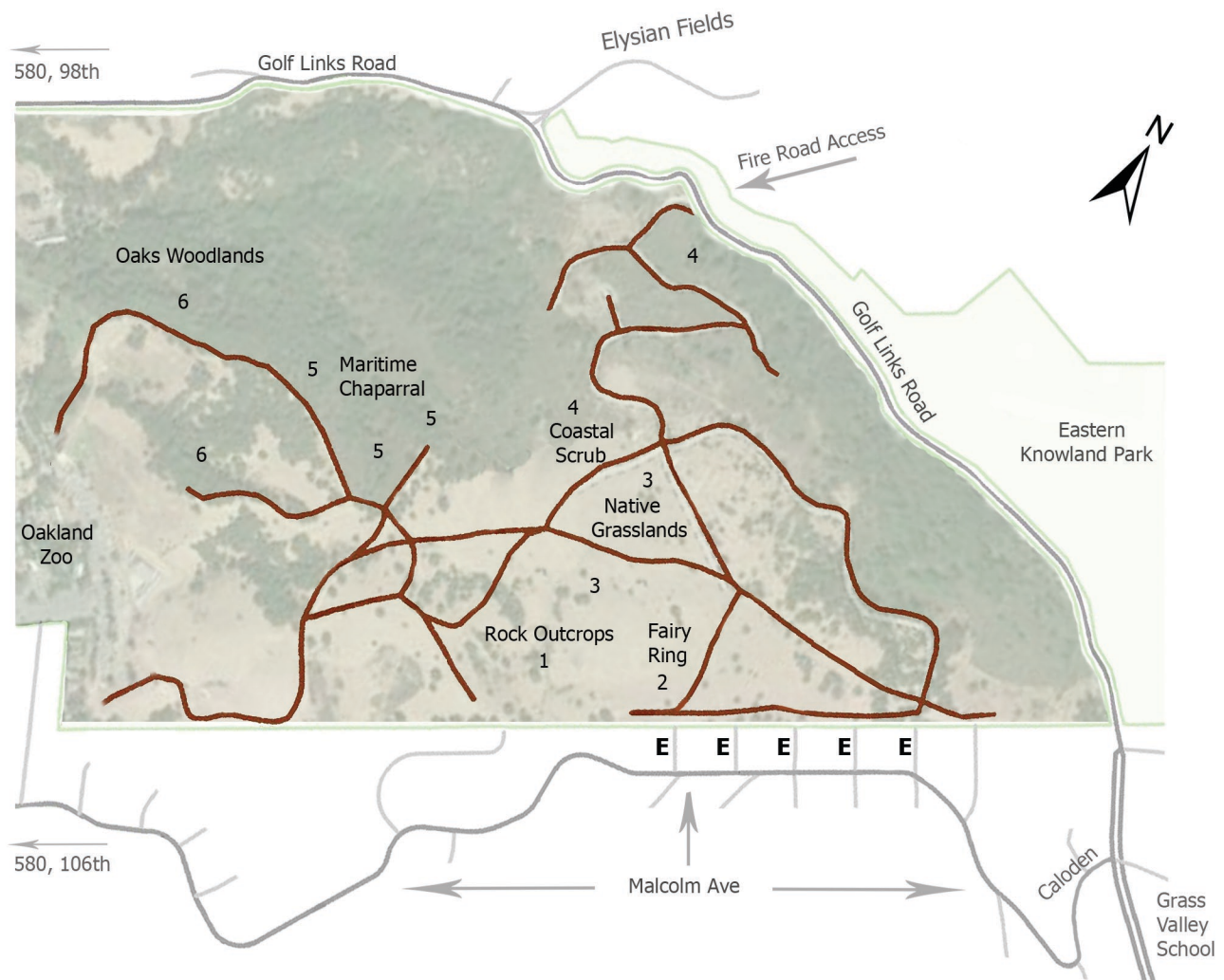


Western Knowland Park

Trails:

The trails shown on the map are all fire roads. There are a few more unmarked paths made by animals or hikers. The fire roads have been conduits for invasive plants and non-native grasses to disperse, but for now they provide good access to many wonderful parts of Western Knowland Park.

Look For:

- 1 - Rock outcrops: Crusting lichens
- 2 - Fairy ring: Giant puffballs
- 3 - Grassland: Purple needlegrass
- 4 - Coastal scrub: Sticky monkey flower
- 5 - Maritime chaparral: Brittleleaf manzanita
- 6 - Oak woodland: Assorted native flowers

E - Enter the park through one of the paths at Snowdown, Cameron, Lochard, Ettrick, Elvessa, or Fallbrook Way

Directions: From 580 exit at 98th, take Golf Links Road up the hill and around the park. After road divides, turn R on Caloden which turns into Malcolm Ave.. Alternatively take 106 to Malcolm. Ascend Malcolm to the top of the hill.

No Facilities: Note that there are no restrooms or trash cans. Please carry out your trash.
